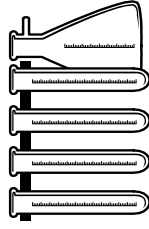


What is a Science Fair?

Nuevo Community Church's Annex Building is the site for our 2006 Science Fair. The church's address is 29734 Nuevo Road, Nuevo, California.

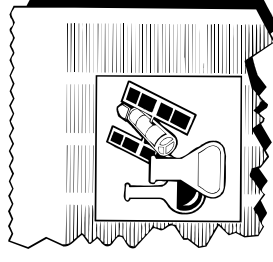

What is the cost of the Science Fair?

The registration fee is \$10 per project for the first two projects per family. Additional registrations (3 or more) are \$5 each. If you register by mail, there is a \$3.00 charge to ship you the Science Fair information packet. (Make your check payable to Irene Miles.)

What is the collections division in the Science Fair?

Collections can be a good way to interest a child in the sciences. Scientific collections can be entered in our Science Fair. Collections can be entered either in "Beginner" or "Advanced" categories.

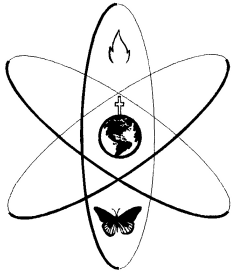

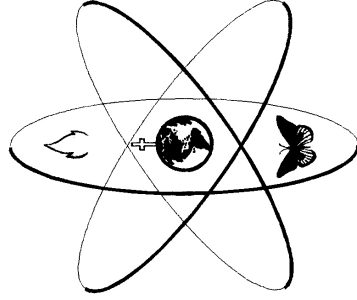
